

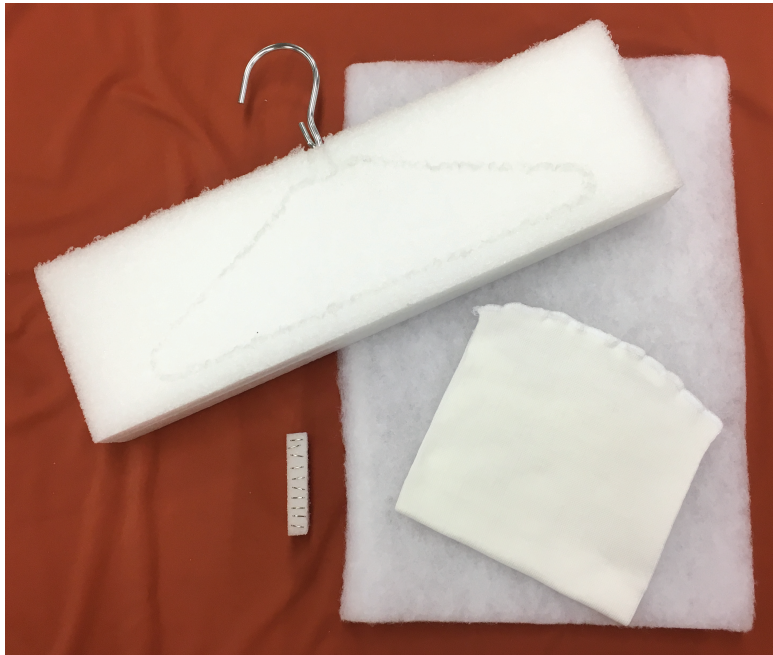
CONSERVATION HANGER KIT

Thank you for purchasing the Conservation Hanger Kit!

The basic structure is as follows: the Ethafoam® block measures 2" x 5" x 15.5" with an aluminum hanger embedded inside. The aluminum hanger measures about 12" across the shoulders, so you have several inches leeway to carve. You can carve the hanger to hang facing either right or left. A sharp knife like a steak knife or produce knife can be used. We highly recommend using an electric knife.

After carving your hanger, cut a small slit in the center of the padding square, and slide it over the hanger hook, draping it to fit. Pinch out a dart of excess padding at the center back. You can stabilize with a pin if you like. Trim off excess padding from underneath hanger.

You will need to make a tiny snip in the polyester stockinette cover in order to put the hanger hook through. Find the center of the seamline, and snip a single thread directly next to the seam. Do NOT cut the seam stitching. Turn the cover so that the seam is to the inside. Put the end of the hanger through the cut and ease the seams toward the ends of the hanger. Stretch the cover over first one end of the padded hanger, and then the other. Smooth the cover to under the bottom edge of the hanger. Trim excess fabric and turn the edges under to make a clean finish. Secure with t-pins.
