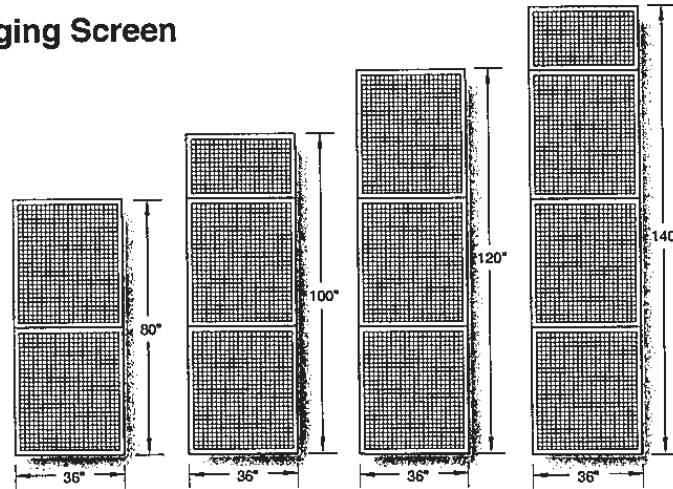
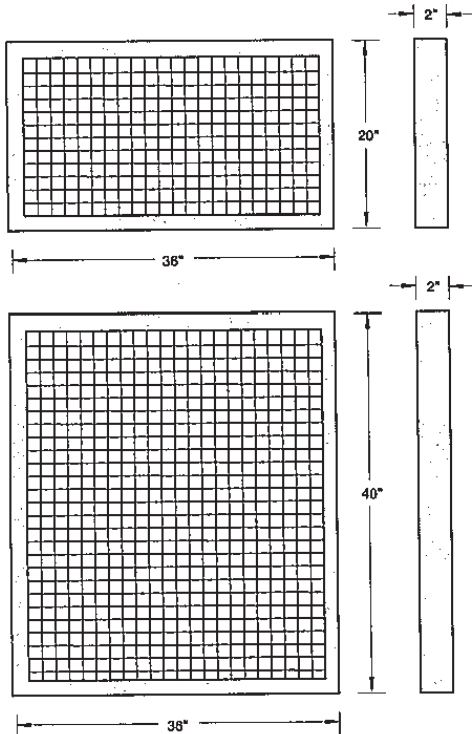


# SpaceNow! CORPORATION ARTGLIDER™ HIGH DENSITY HANGING ART STORAGE SYSTEM

## The Components The Hanging Screen

The basic Screen Module is a steel frame with a heavy-gauge wire grid of 1" spacing. Standard modules are 36" wide by 20" high and by 40" high. They are simply assembled to form screens of different heights as illustrated.

### Basic Screen Modules



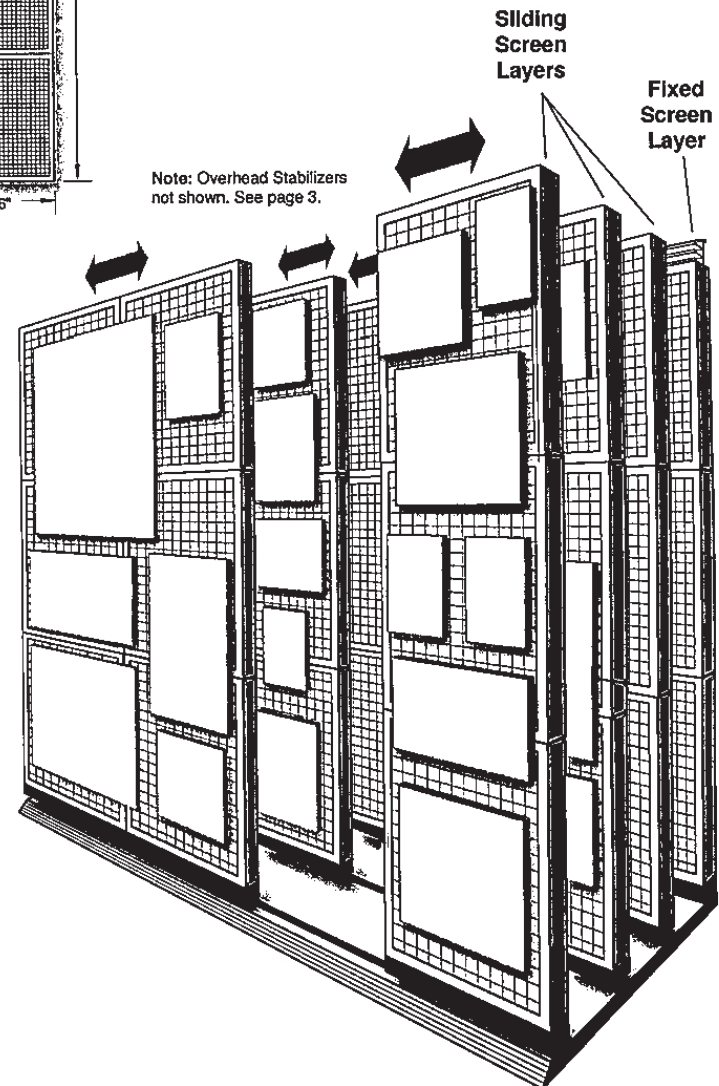
### Typical Assembled Screen Sizes

### Example: 4-Layer system 12 feet wide

The rear layer of screens forms a fixed, continuous hanging wall. Screens in the front 3 layers slide from side-to-side to allow access to the paintings in any of the layers. The sliding screens may be used singly or linked together to form wider screens for larger works.

As illustrated, this ArtGlider system occupies a space only 144" wide by 41" deep and offers 390 square feet of hanging surface — equal to a wall 39 feet long by 10 feet high.



Hanging clips engage the grid at any point to hold wire or "D" rings attached to the works. "Snap-on" feature prevents clips from disengaging the grid when pictures are being hung. Custom brackets to hold rolled textiles, costumes, weapons and other artifacts as well as shelves can be provided.
